Suffolk County Becomes UAV Threat Detection Proving Grounds

First-in-the nation initiative fights contraband smuggling into prisons.

RIVERHEAD, NY -- June 16, 2016 -- Integris Security LLC, a security technology and services company, today announced new anti-smuggling protections for prisons.

The Suffolk County Correctional Facility in Riverhead, New York, now has the ability to detect unauthorized Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), a.k.a. drones, that approach or breach its secure perimeter. This first-in-the nation technology initiative has been implemented at the Riverhead Correctional Facility and is operated by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office. The solution is designed to prevent the smuggling of mobile phones, drugs, weapons and other contraband into the jail.

Through the cooperation of both public and private organizations including the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office, the Suffolk County Correction Officers Association, Dedrone and Integris Security, this multi-sensor hardware and software solution provides enhanced security within the physical space of the correctional facility. The technology can also be applied to airports, sports stadiums, and other facilities requiring a high degree of security, as well as virtually any venue where people converge. It is ideal for both civilian and law enforcement use in a variety of missions focusing on safety, crime prevention, and anti-terrorism.

Retired NYPD Captain Joseph Concannon, President of Integris Security, said, "Drones are the latest threat not just at our prisons, but also at our airports and transportation hubs, sporting venues, and shopping malls. Businesses and government agencies need

to respond to these threats quickly and effectively, and this new technology will help then do that.”
